Byelaw for the Regulation of Dogs

Byelaw made by Alresford Parish Council under Section 164 of the Public Health Act 1875 and section 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906 for the regulation of public walks and pleasure grounds and of open spaces and burial grounds respectively.

EXTENT

- 1.(1) Byelaw 3 applies to the recreation ground in St. Andrews Close, Ford Lane in the county of Essex hereafter referred to as the "dog prohibited area".
- 1.(2) Notice of the effect of this byelaw shall be given by a sign placed in a conspicuous position at the entrance to the recreation ground.

INTERPRETATION

2. (1) In this byelaw "the Council" means Alresford Parish Council.
2. (2) For the purpose of this byelaw, the keeper of the dog shall be deemed in charge thereof, unless the Court is satisfied that the dog had been placed in or taken into the charge of some other person at the time when the offence had been committed.
- 2.(3) In paragraph (2) above "the keeper" shall include the owner of the dog or any person who habitually has it in his possession.

DOGS PROHIBITED FROM THE GROUND

- 3.(1) No person in charge of a dog (other than a registered blind or disabled person in charge of a dog) shall without reasonable excuse, permit the dog to enter or remain in the dog prohibited area.
